A complete application should include:

1. Statement of interest

In a 1-2 page letter, please describe why you are an excellent fit for the faculty of the Youth Orchestra of St. Luke's. In your letter please address the following questions:

- In what ways should a youth orchestra be responsive and/or relevant to its community?
- In what ways do you think access to orchestral music education impacts the learning of a young person? What experiences do you draw on (either as a teacher or learner) in these areas?
- How does a faculty position at the Youth Orchestra of St. Luke's figure into your trajectory as a music educator and/or performer?
- Please also use this opportunity to fill in any other information about yourself that does not fit within your resume.

2. Resume

Please submit a resume that includes educational training, teaching, performance, and any other relevant professional experience.

3. Sample teaching

We will ask applicants to teach a sample lesson with students from one of our partner sites. Alternatively, applicants can provide a link to a 20 minute video which demonstrates your teaching in a group setting.

4. Sample performance video

Please provide a link to a 5 minute video which demonstrates your proficiency on the instrument you elect to teach. Live auditions can also be scheduled.

5. Reference List

Please provide three references, their professional affiliations and titles, and contact information. Include people who are familiar with your teaching or have worked with you in a professional context as an employer or colleague.

Incomplete applications will not be considered. Applicants whose materials have passed the first round of review will be invited to interview with our Director of Education and Manager of Youth Programs. Final round candidates will be asked to teach a 20 minute sample class with a group of YOSL students, and decisions will be announced in August 2019.
